Dear Sir,

Will you allow me the profit of the opportunity which has offered, to beg you to accept a copy of these letters I have lately addressed to my old friend, the [2] Earl of Elgin on the Expediency of adopting the Greek in preference to the Gothic Style of Architecture for the new Home of Parliament now building in this metropolis ? And who to present the other Copy in my name to the Library of Your University.
