Dear Sir

If not inconvenient to you, I propose doing myself the Pleasure of waiting on you on Friday morning about ten o'clock, & if you will allow me, of staying dinner - I promise myself much satisfaction & improvement from the candid observations you were kind enough to offer, concerning my translation . I will bring the Corpus delicti with me.
