My dear Sir

You will have learnt that we have re-opened our proceedings in the R. Asiatic Society under favourable auspices. There has been an interesting [2] paper on the valley of the Setledge in the Himálaya, which passed through my hands - It will be inserted in the forthcoming fasciculus.

I am sorry to say our friend D<sup>r</sup> Noehden is not well - He has had several attacks of illness within the last few months

Shall I request you to tell my son that his brothers are well and are often thinking of him? They hope he does not forget them
