This will be presented to you by M^r Cohen a young Man of letters well versed in German & Scandinavian literature for whom I beg your Civilities – You can procure him [2] access to Libraries &c – Should you wish to write to me which I hope you will he will take charge of your letters – Remember me to Constant – Tell me how all the Friends of M^e de S are –
